#### What is Turnitin?

- A plagiarism detection system
- Checks submitted papers for text matches to following sources:
  - Current and archived internet content
  - Professional, academic and commercial journals and publications
  - Student previously submitted papers




#### Process of using Turnitin






# Submit papers (1/2)

- Each Assignment can be uploaded 3 times (but new articles will overwrite the old ones). From the 4th time upload, you must wait at least 24 hours to get the report, so please make good use of ten Assignments to upload in turn.




